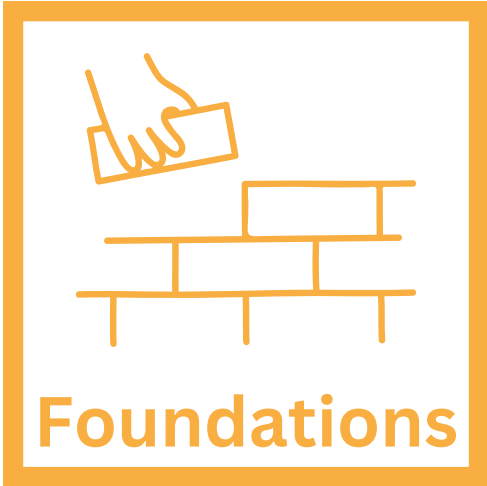

The more we spend time with God, the more we will become like Him.



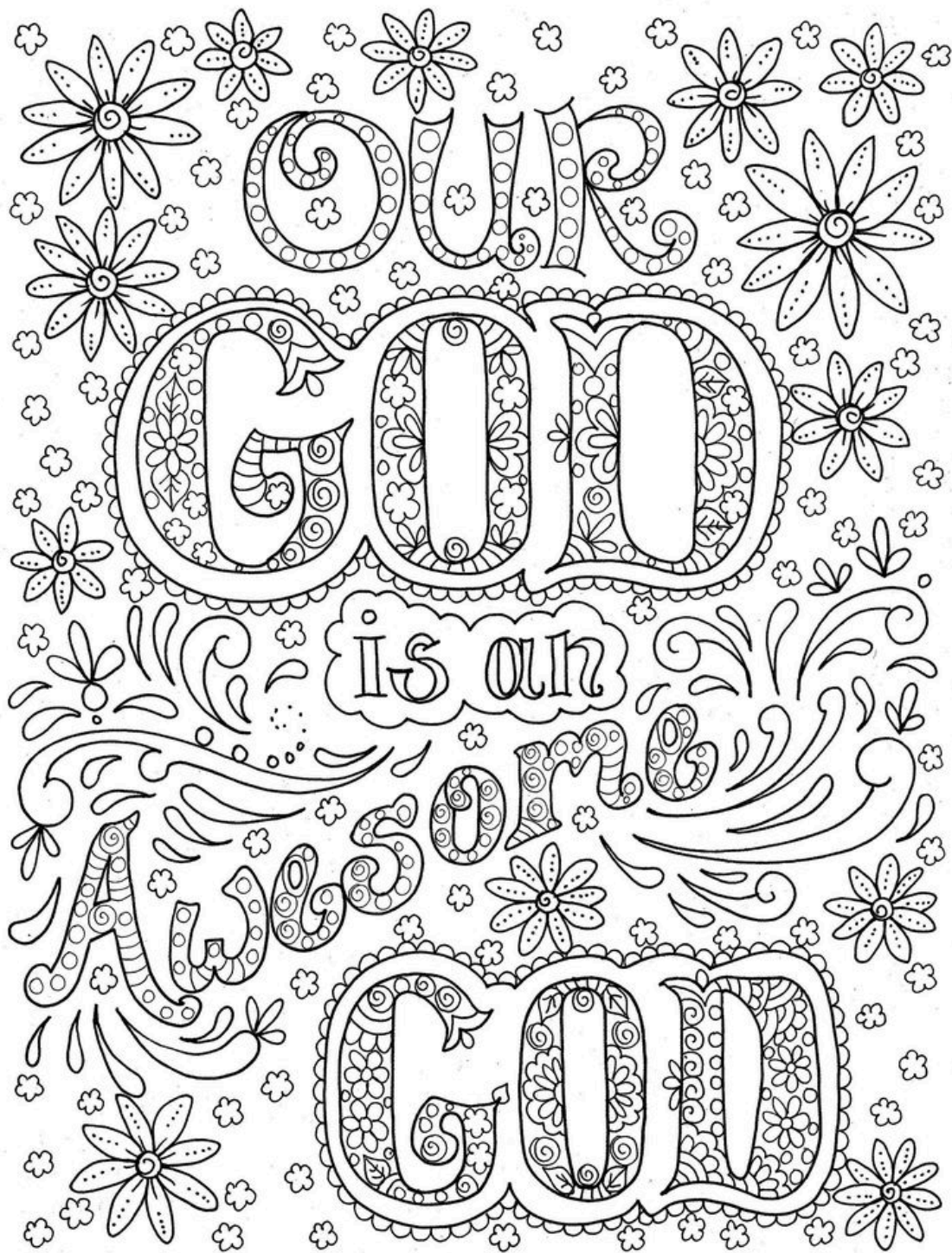
God is working in us to change us little by little.

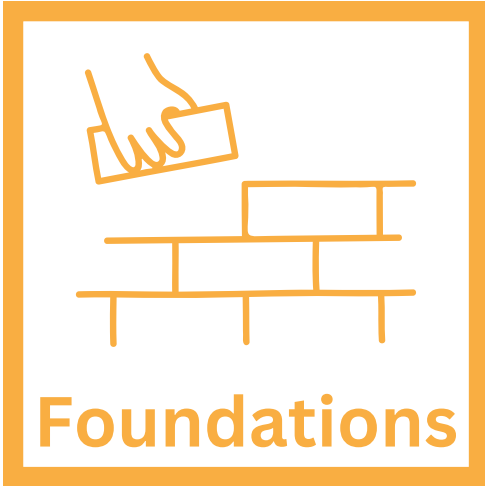
