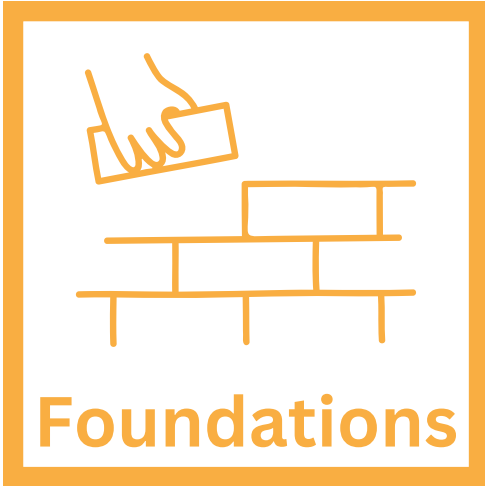

God's people are the church.



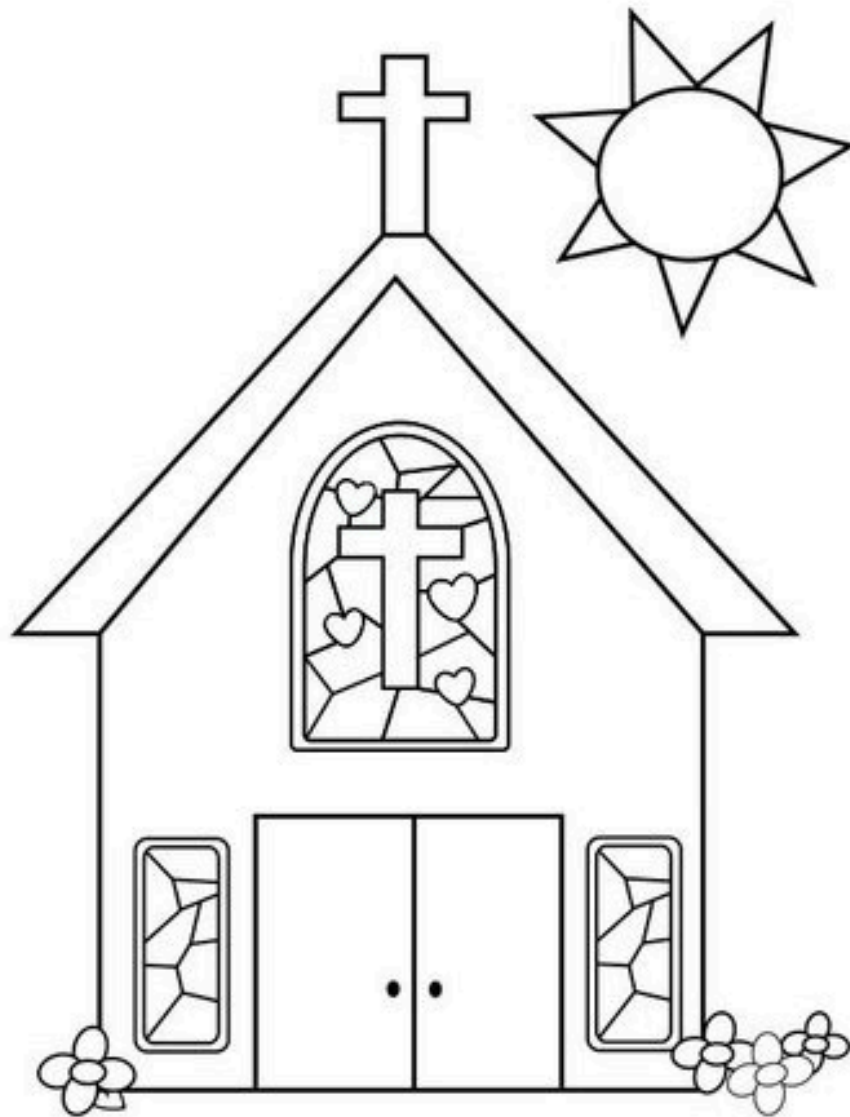

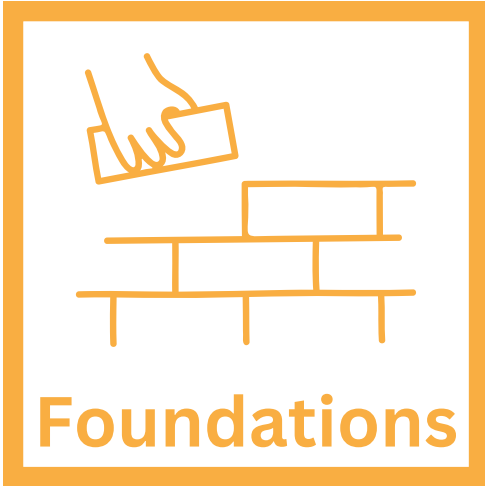
